Dear Chief Commissioner,

Greater Sydney has a strong strategic foundation with the three cities vision. The focus now needs to be on delivering key precincts within Greater Sydney to deliver on this vision.

The Commission will lead the accelerated delivery and coordination of key precincts, incorporating social and economic benefits as well as sustainability into the strategic development of each. It is clear that with the involvement of many government and non-government stakeholders, these precincts will act as catalysts for broader economic growth and be purposely designed to complement and reinforce each other. The Commission will focus on those precincts with the greatest opportunity to accelerate economic recovery and that are consistent with the Greater Sydney Region Plan, the NSW Economic Blueprint and Global NSW.

In consultation with the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces and the Minister for Jobs, Investment, Tourism and Western Sydney, the Commission will focus on the following precincts. Additional precincts may be added at my nomination, in consultation with impacted Ministers.

- Technology Precinct from Central to Eveleigh, including Tech Central
- Westmead Innovation Precinct, including Parramatta North
- Macquarie Park Innovation District
- Meadowbank Education Precinct.

I also request the Commision develop a Central Coast strategy which outlines future opportunities for the region. This work should include consultations and engagement with key stakeholders.

In addition, the Commission will continue to perform its statutory functions including the provision of advice to the NSW Government upon request, coordinating implementation of the Greater Sydney Region Plan (GSRP), and assuring key local and state plans, strategies and policies.

I have requested that Infrastructure NSW review the timing of the next State Infrastructure Strategy (SIS) with a view to accelerating its completion in 2022. In this context, it is my expectation that the Commission's review and update of the GSRP and District Plans be completed simultaneously with the SIS in accordance with statutory requirements.

I also expect the Commission to continue to identify and implement initiatives in accordance with its role as independent adviser to the NSW Government, consistent with the objectives and functions of the *Greater Sydney Commission Act 2015*.

I look forward to the Commission's continued success under your leadership.
